INTERCESSORY PRAYER

Isaiah 59:16a

**And He saw that there was no man,
And was astonished that there was no one to
intercede...**

In a fallen world, not all that happens is God's perfect plan. Humanity was given authority, and ceded it to Satan. It's up to us to take back our authority and stand in the gap between the evil that is happening (God's permissive will), and call in what He wants (God's perfect will). Intercession is prayer that discerns His will and calls it into being. It's partnership with the Divine. It's praying "On Earth as it is in Heaven."

What is Prayer?

- God would love to speak with you!
- Prayer is simply speaking to God.
- Speak normally from the heart (like speaking to a close friend).
- Be honest and transparent.
- You can thank Him, tell Him about your day, ask Him things, praise Him, tell Him your concerns, or ask Him what is on His heart.
- Spend some time quietly listening.
- Keep coming back.

What is Intercessory Prayer?

- Prayer has many forms: Devotional, contemplative, adoration, worship, etc.
- Intercession starts with asking:
 - What's on Your heart, God?
 - What is happening that grieves Your heart?
 - What is Your perfect will in this situation?"
- Then faith calls a thing that is on God's heart in Heaven into being on Earth.
