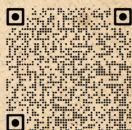

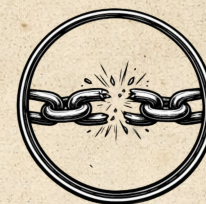

DELIVERANCE MINISTRY

Mark 16:17a

"And these signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons..."

First Steps to Freedom

- Forgive those who need to be forgiven
- Repent—admit, ask forgiveness, and fully turn away
- Renounce—break any agreements with the sin, person, group or activity
- Breaking Soul Ties—Breaking ungodly connections with people, groups, or spirits
- Healing Emotional Wounds
- House Cleansing—Asking God to reveal objects that need to be removed, praying cleansing prayers, and dedicating the house for Jesus.

Ministering Deliverance

- Discern and be led by the Holy Spirit!
- Love and care for the person is prime.
- Identify and close open doors.
- Lead the individual to repent, renounce, & forgive.
- Bind and command to go.
- Take authority until there is a release.
- Invite the Holy Spirit to fill the vacated places.
